Youth MTB Coordinator:

Reports to the WCC President

Primary responsibility is the continuation of the youth MTB program. Focused on kids in the age range of 10 to 16, possibly older. This will be for novice riders with emphasis on basic riding skills and safety. Develop new skill lessons and coordinate youth participation in race events.

Funding may be available from the Community Grants program. Responsible to assist with the development of flyers, club brochures and advertising requirements

High School Cycling Program:

Reports to the President

Work with the President to Create a competitive high school mountain bike team. This may be a pilot program with a single high school or made available to all area schools right away. Sponsorship funds will be available to assist with the program. There will be weekend time required for out of town races.
